



NORTH CAROLINA ODYSSEY OF THE MIND 2019-2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



North Carolina Odyssey of the Mind (NCOM) is pleased to announce **four** college scholarships available to current and/or former Odyssey of the Mind participants. Each scholarship is a one-time scholarship of \$1,000. Recipients must demonstrate creative problem-solving skills as well as outstanding sportsmanship, perseverance, and teamwork skills. To be eligible for the NCOM Scholarship, you must:

- Have participated for a minimum of one year in Odyssey of the Mind from team creation through competition.
- Be a high school senior with plans to attend college, university, or a vocational school in the fall of 2020 **OR** be a full-time student currently enrolled in a college, university, or vocational school.
- Not be a previous Odyssey of the Mind scholarship recipient.
- First consideration will be given to applicants for the Susan Lawson Memorial Scholarship who are enrolled in undergraduate education programs or are pursuing higher degrees in the education field. **The Lawson scholarship is open to team members, coaches, and other Odyssey of the Mind volunteers.**

2019-2020 SCHOLARSHIPS:

- **Lester and Athelene Carter Scholarship** – In recognition for over 30 years of faithful service to the Odyssey of the Mind program and NCOM.
- **Susan C. Hultin Memorial Scholarship** - Susan Hultin was an educator in the Charlotte Mecklenburg School System and a strong supporter of NCOM (Funded by a grant established by her family)
- **Andy Moore Memorial Scholarship** – Andy Moore was a dedicated, long-time Easter Region coach who made lasting contributions to Odyssey teams and the program. (Co-Sponsored by donations and the Eastern Region Board)
- **Susan Lawson Memorial Scholarship** – Susan Lawson was a long-time educator, regional director, state board member, state problem captain, coach, mentor, and guiding light for Odyssey of the Mind and NCOM. (Co-Sponsored by NCOM and donations)

Mail all of the following documents to the address listed below:

1. Your NCOM Scholarship Application Form (pages 2-3 below).
2. A **Personal Inquiry** response to **ONE** of the following three questions. Your response may take any form, format, or style you wish but please limit your response to no more than two pages double spaced.
 - a. **How has Odyssey of the Mind affected / influenced your life?**
 - b. **Describe your most memorable Odyssey of the Mind experiences. How will your experiences continue to be a part of your life?**
 - c. **What personal characteristics have you developed from your involvement in Odyssey of the Mind? How will you further develop those characteristics?**
3. **ONE** letter of recommendation from an **Odyssey of the Mind** coach, limited to one page, double spaced. The letter should address the student's creative problem-solving skills, spontaneous problem-solving ability, and teamwork and leadership skills. Please use the attached form.
4. **ONE** letter of recommendation from a school official (high school administrator, teacher or counselor, or college professor or advisor) limited to one page, double-spaced on current school stationery. The letter should address the student's creative problem-solving ability, sportsmanship, perseverance and teamwork skills. Please use the attached form for reference.
5. Copy of high school transcript (for high school applicant) **and/or** college transcript (for college applicant)
