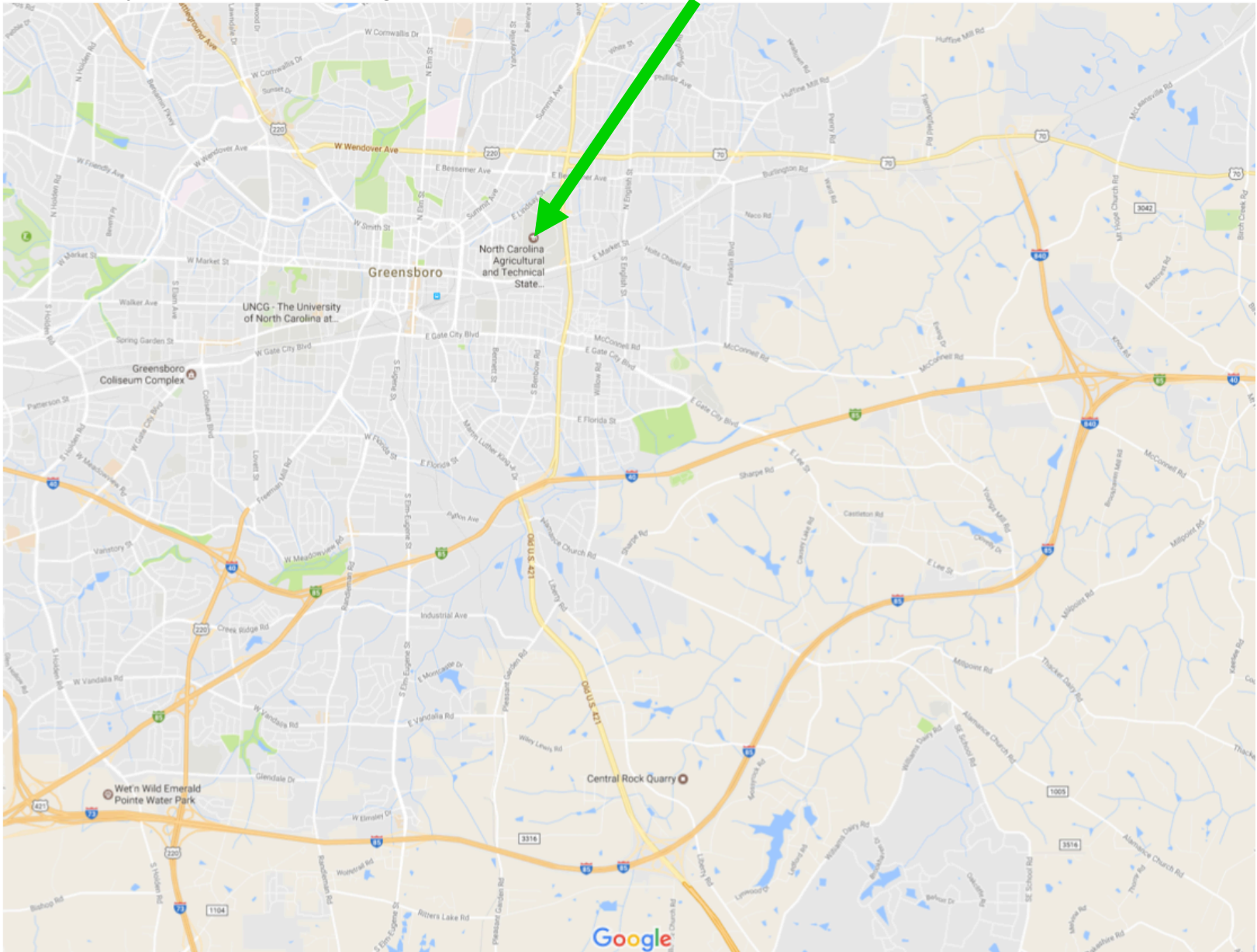

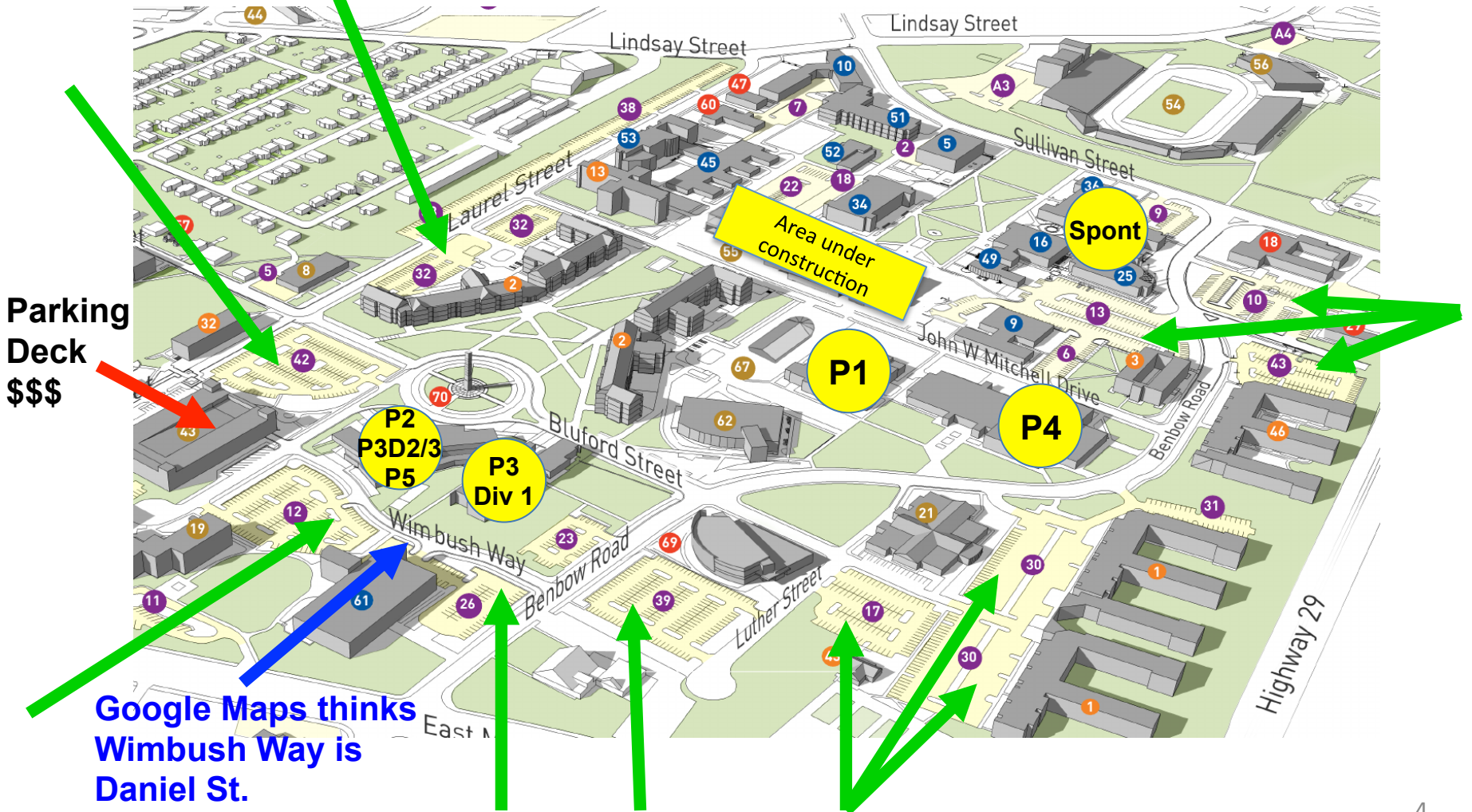

# NCOM Tournament Long Term Parking

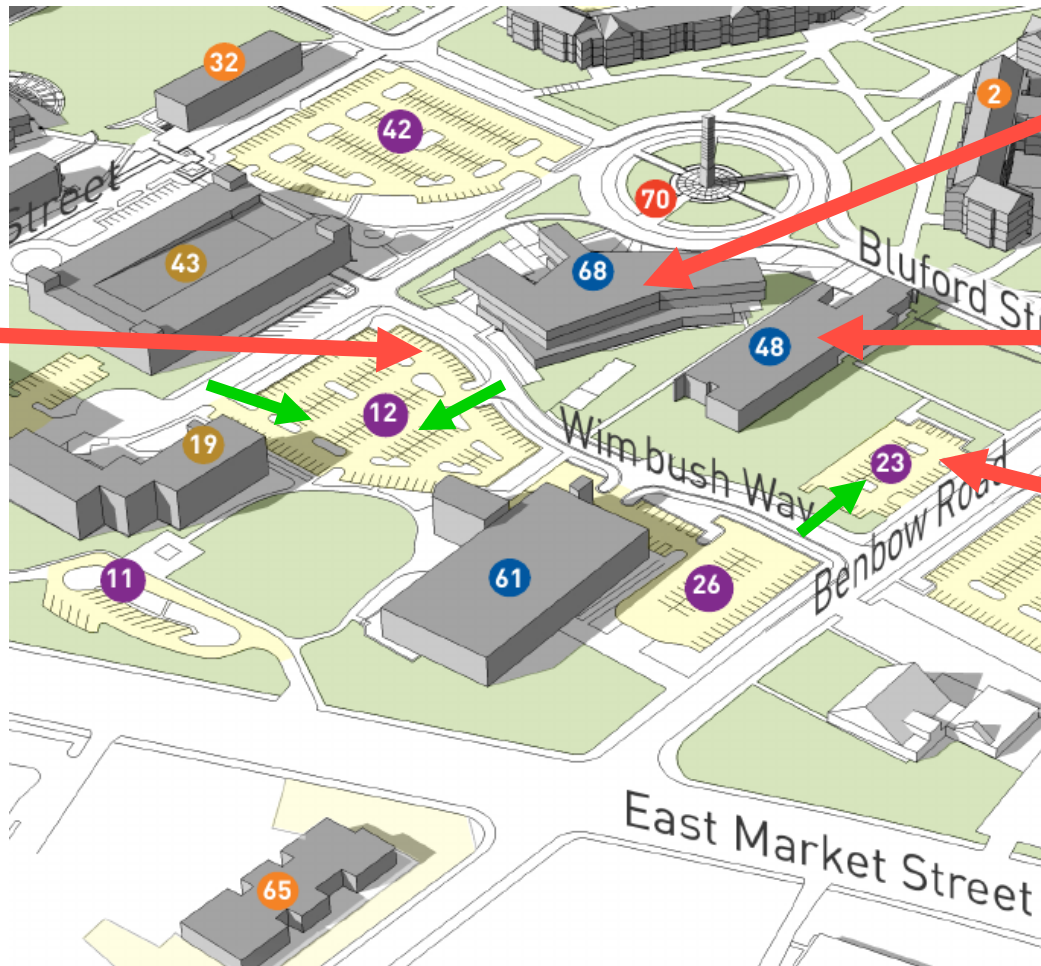
Note: surface lots (green arrows) are free parking

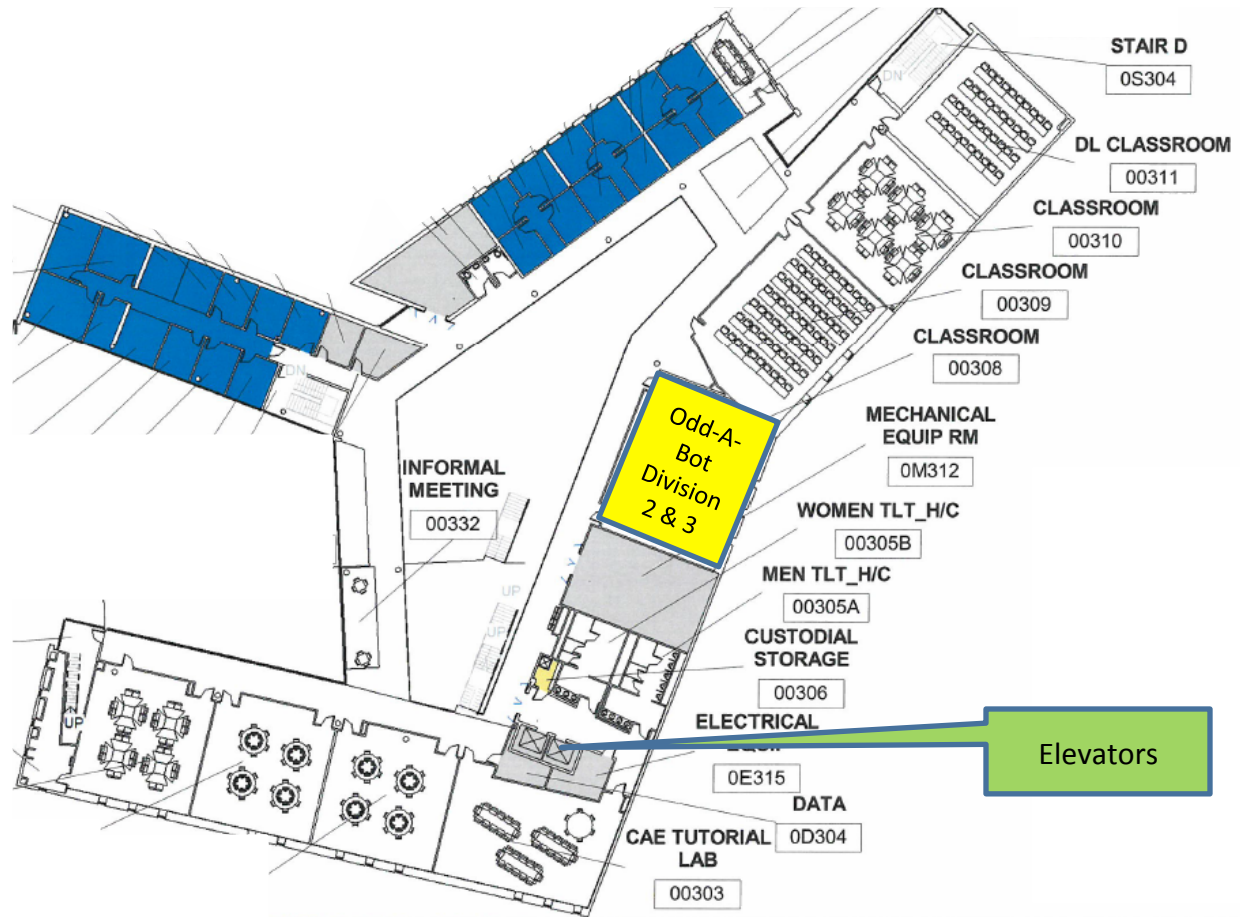
# Academic Classroom Building – First Floor

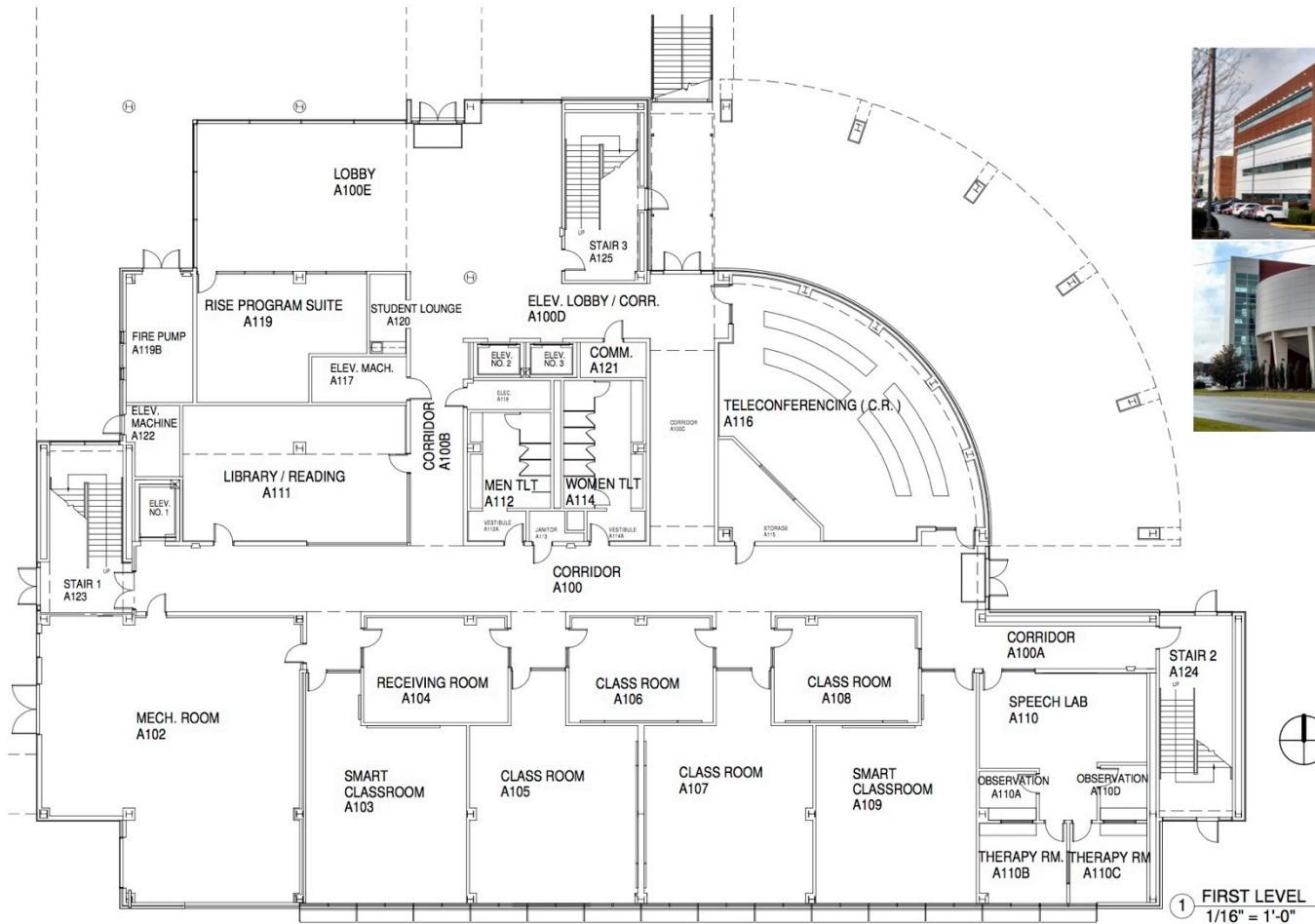

5. Collect your free souvenir.



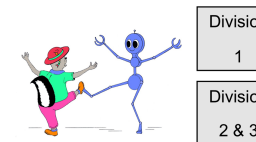

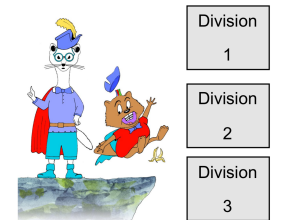
